**Cost:** \$225 (\$9.38/week)


Enrollment Deadline: January 15, 2018

Our trial run of the 2017 CSA was a great success with those who picked up regularly receiving far more than \$8/week worth of produce! 2018's CSA is planned to be bigger and longer with more intensive planting and crop production. The season will include my entire property worth of flowers, fruit and vegetables. Everything will be open to be harvested as the season allows. This will expand the selection tremendously and allow for production in the the best-suited soils and locations.

The 2018 CSA will include vegetables, fruits, flowers, and herbs all grown with certified organic treatments, as needed.



The Picking times will likely be managed as they were for 2017 with a few possible changes. The proposed schedule & changes is below:

- Pick ups are Saturday and Sunday only from 7 am dark unless otherwise arranged. If you pick up during those times there's no need to contact me unless you have questions.
- The amount you may harvest is determined by weather, growing patterns and quantity available. I use a series of different sized baskets that you may fill. This will be communicated week to week.
- We will be establishing a private, closed facebook group specifically for the CSA. You will be added once the membership is paid in full. In it I will post updates, photos and explanations of how to use your harvest. This is the most convenient and efficient way to communicate with the group and will allow members to refer back to posts for things they might want to revisit.
- The facebook group will also allow me to get feedback from members if we don't usually see each other face to face during the season.



### **Details and FAQs**

- Weekend harvesting runs from May 1 Oct 15 (24 weeks)
- Includes a large variety of unique fruits, vegetables, medicinal plants, herbs and flowers
- All organically grown, mostly heirloom varieties will be planted. I only plant hybrids when conditions demand it such as plants that are particularly susceptible to fungus and disease.
- Pick up is once a week (Saturday or Sunday only) and quantities will vary with what can be harvested
- Eight shares available at \$225 each. Full payment due by March 30, 2018.
- You are welcome to come and help in the garden but it is not a requirement. I will do all the planning, planting, weeding, watering and tending. I've found that I am a better planter than harvester. This is a way to fuel my passion for gardening and feed my community nutritionally-dense, organically-grown food.
- Shares will be first come, first served. Your spot will be held by payment only.
- If you purchase a share, you will be added to a closed, private facebook group for the CSA. Your information will come through this.
- CSA shares are NON-REFUNDABLE.
   Despite poor weather, pests and disease, supporting a CSA is a vote for your farmer and helps them continue to provide clean food to the community.
